Please don't take offense to the request to show your pass. The pool is for POA Members and a limited number of their guests. These rules have been developed to protect swimmers and property owners as well. Please help in making sure not only YOU but others are following them! It is your responsibility as a POA member!

POOL RULES

No lifeguard on duty, swim at your own risk
No loud music
No parties, unless authorized
No running or diving
No alcoholic beverages within 50 feet of pool or pavilion
Only for POA Members and their guests
Must have a pool tag to swim
Only 6 guests allowed for any member at one time
No profane language
Must keep gate to pool closed

Anyone 13 or under must be accompanied by an adult
Must be dressed in proper swimming attire
No floating devices allowed when pool is crowded
Pool open from 9am - 9 pm
Pool closed on Mondays
No food or drinks allowed in pool area
No pets allowed in pool area
Stay off fence
